

Need help printing personalized claim forms?

Additional security features have been added to recent versions of *Adobe Reader* which prevent our personalized claim forms from automatically filling in your personal information. If you have *Adobe Reader* version 9.3.2 or greater, additional steps should be taken to allow this feature to operate again.

Here's what you need to do

1. Open Adobe Reader
2. On the "Edit" menu, select "Preferences"
3. In the "Preferences" window, select "Security (Enhanced)"
4. Click on the "Add Host" button
5. In the "Add Privileged Host" window, type in "**onlineservices.greenshield.ca**" and check the box for "Secure connections only (https:)"
6. Click OK on the remaining windows and exit

You should now be able to print your personalized claim forms. If your personal information does not appear on the selected form, please refresh the web page by using your browser refresh button or hitting F5.

For Google Chrome users: The Chrome browser has a default pdf viewer built in which is not compatible with personalized claim forms. After following the steps above, please complete the following steps to enable this feature in your Chrome browser.

Step 1: Open Chrome and type "about:plugins" into the omnibox at the top.

Step 2: Scroll down and find Chrome PDF Viewer.

Step 3: Click the "Disable" link to prevent PDFs from loading within Chrome.

There should be a corresponding entry for Adobe Acrobat® which should be enabled.
